Someone who understands that behaviour is communication, that relationships matter, and that real change takes time.

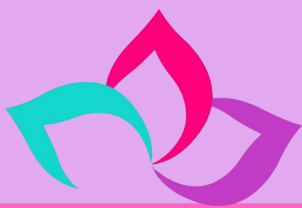
